Hundreds Visit Radius Specialty Hospital Quincy During June 6 Grand Opening

QUINCY—More than two hundred people visited Radius Specialty Hospital Quincy over the course of its grand opening celebration on Wednesday June 6. Physicians, case managers, and other staff from Boston and South Shore hospitals met with Radius staff M.D.s and administrators and toured the 38-bed long-term acute care facility, operating within Quincy Medical Center since April.

“We are pleased to be here in Quincy, serving a number of communities throughout the South Shore,” said William F. Duffy, Radius Specialty Hospital Chief Executive Officer. “It’s clear from the initial response from referring hospitals that we are meeting a need for high quality care for medically complex patients.” According to Duffy, the unit is more than half full in only it’s second month of operation.

Radius Specialty Hospital Quincy is the second Radius long-term acute care hospital, joining Radius Specialty Hospital Boston, which opened in 2005.
